Dear resident,

While responding to the current pandemic has rightly been a priority in recent weeks, it is vital that work also continues on other important issues affecting Runnymede and Weybridge.

The current crisis and its impact on the NHS highlights more than ever the need for effective, innovative and accessible health services. The Weybridge health centre was a crucial and much loved centre of care for people living in Weybridge and beyond, and I have been engaging with North West Surrey CCG regarding the future of the site.

The ongoing consultation on the future of walk-in centres, in response to new government guidelines, does mean changes will have to be made to how services were previously delivered. I have published the latest letter I have received from the CCG, and will continue to press for further detail on the services which will available under each possible outcome.
